INTRODUCTION

PROGRAMME DURATION

PROGRAMME CONTENT

The second year integrates the acquired knowledge and encompasses advanced knowledge and skills pertaining to aesthetic medicine.

The four modules over a period of two years will include the following information:

- Module 3: Aesthetic Medicine and related procedures part 1
- Module 4: Aesthetic medicine and related procedures part 2
